Who can Benefit from Pharmacogenetic Testing?

Genetic variability can affect how the body responds to certain medications. Pharmacogenetic testing and pharmacist virtual visits can help predict the type of medications and doses that may be best for your patients.

Common examples include:

- Depression / Anxiety (SSRIs)
- Pain (Opioids, NSAIDs)
- GERD / H.Pylori / Ulcers (PPIs)
- Cardiovascular (Clopidogrel, Statins, Warfarin)

How Testing Works

-  Patients complete a simple, non-invasive cheek swab at home in just minutes, or securely upload existing pharmacogenetic test results.
-  Patients have a video visit with a pharmacogenetics- specialized pharmacist to learn about the results and ask any questions.
-  Results are sent to the referring health care provider who can review the results and recommendations and then adjust medications as needed.
